Looking ahead, Scooby and his team are preparing for a monumental show at the Pyramids of Egypt in 2025, where more than





Made with durable neoprene, BORSA FRESCA is water and heat-resistant, featuring two reusable ice packs that elevate its cooling capability. While it functions well without the ice packs, its versatility extends beyond cosmetics. It has been used to keep cell phones from overheating and even to accompany users into saunas, safeguarding devices while playing music or podcasts. The bag's design is equally stylish, offering options to carry it as a purse with a strap or as a wristlet for added functionality.

The concept originated over 26 years ago when Claudia, a busy multitasker, grew tired of her makeup melting in her car or her sunscreen and lotions being ruined during outdoor adventures. Her innovative solution was born from a real need, one many can relate to, and it has since grown into a practical yet chic solution for everyday life.

Juggling careers in real estate and human services, Claudia acknowledges the challenges of managing her time and introducing a brandnew product to the market. "Promoting something entirely new takes time and effort, even with the advantages of social media," she shares. Despite



This is something Neda understands well. "Good design never outshines the individual," she says. "It enhances them."



RIC ROBERTS has been a recognizable figure in Hollywood for decades, with a career spanning over 700 roles in film and television. Golden Globe nomination, a sign of the promise he carried into the following decade.



Since opening AzziArt Gallery in 2021, Aziza has worked with over 70 artists, hosting more than







McKeever, who was


